

The Lord's Prayer

Matthew 6:9-13

(9) Pray then like this: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

"Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, bless his holy name!" Psalms 103:1

"Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy. All nations will come and worship you, for your righteous acts have been revealed." Revelation 15:4

(10) Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.

"Teach me to do your will, for you are my God! Let your good Spirit lead me on level ground!" Psalms 143:10

"Then I said, "Behold, I have come; in the scroll of the book it is written of me: I delight to do your will, O my God; your law is within my heart." Psalms 40:7-8

(11) Give us this day our daily bread,

(12) And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors.

"For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you. Give ear, O LORD, to my prayer; listen to my plea for grace." (Psalms 86:5-6)

(13) And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

"Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit. Turn away from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it. The eyes of the LORD are toward the righteous and his ears toward their cry." Psalms 34:13-15
